



Finance (FIN)

Courses

FIN 375. Managerial Finance. 3 Credits.

An introduction to corporate finance. Emphasis will be placed on valuation techniques and long-term financial planning for business entities.

Typically Offered: Fall.

Prerequisite: ACCT 201 and a General Education Math class.

FIN 376. Managerial Finance II. 3 Credits.

A continuation of managerial finance with an emphasis on short-term financial planning for business entities, risk management, use and valuation of options, and selected international corporate finance issues.

Typically Offered: Spring.

Prerequisite: FIN 375 with a grade of C or better.

FIN 380. Principles of Investments. 3 Credits.

A course designed to provide the student with an understanding of the mechanics and principal problems of investing. Topics include the stock market, real estate, mutual funds, gold and collectibles.

Typically Offered: Spring.

FIN 499. Special Topics. 1-4 Credits.

Courses not offered in the regular catalog that provide an opportunity to extend student learning.

Typically Offered: On sufficient demand.

Repeatable: Up to 12 Credits.
